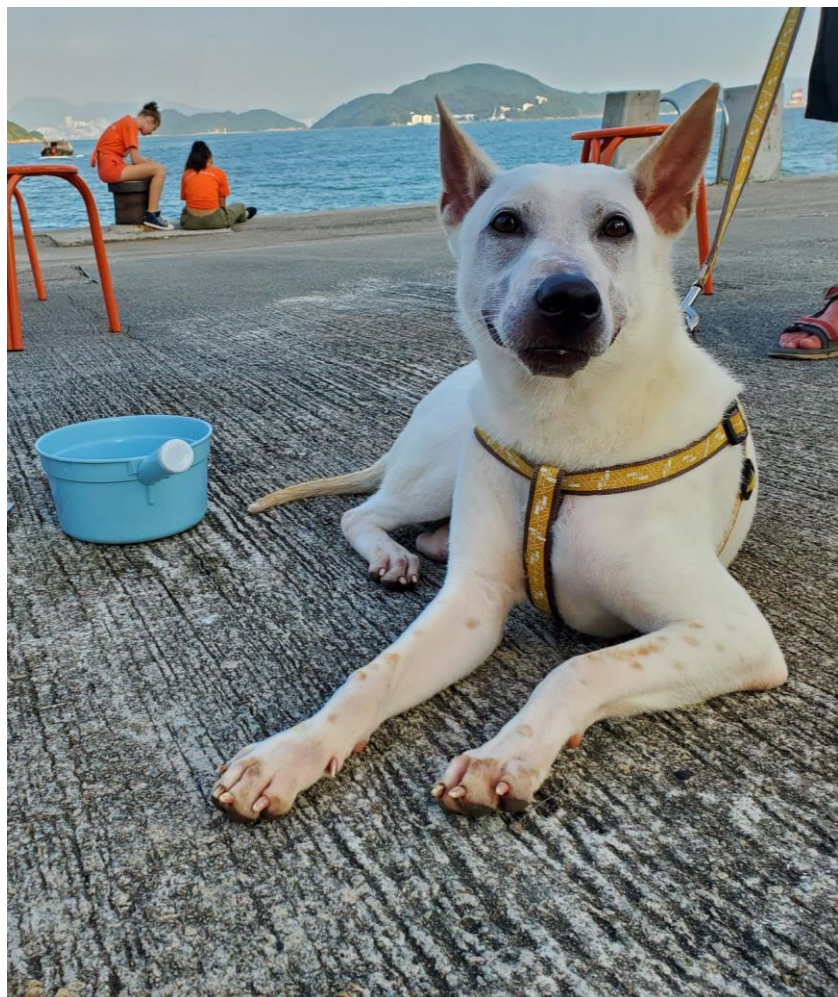




Our Operations



- We are run by unpaid volunteers
- We rely on our foster network for animal care, shelter and rehabilitation
- All animals receive health checks & medical care
- All fosters and adopters go through a vetting process
- We offer a two-week trial adoption in which families can see how the animal settles in and whether they are happy in their new environment
- We offer dog training advice from a certified behaviourist
- We offer medical advice from a registered veterinary surgeon and a registered veterinary nurse
- We provide opportunities for community involvement, and extracurricular activities

Since Dec 2018 we have supported 451 animals

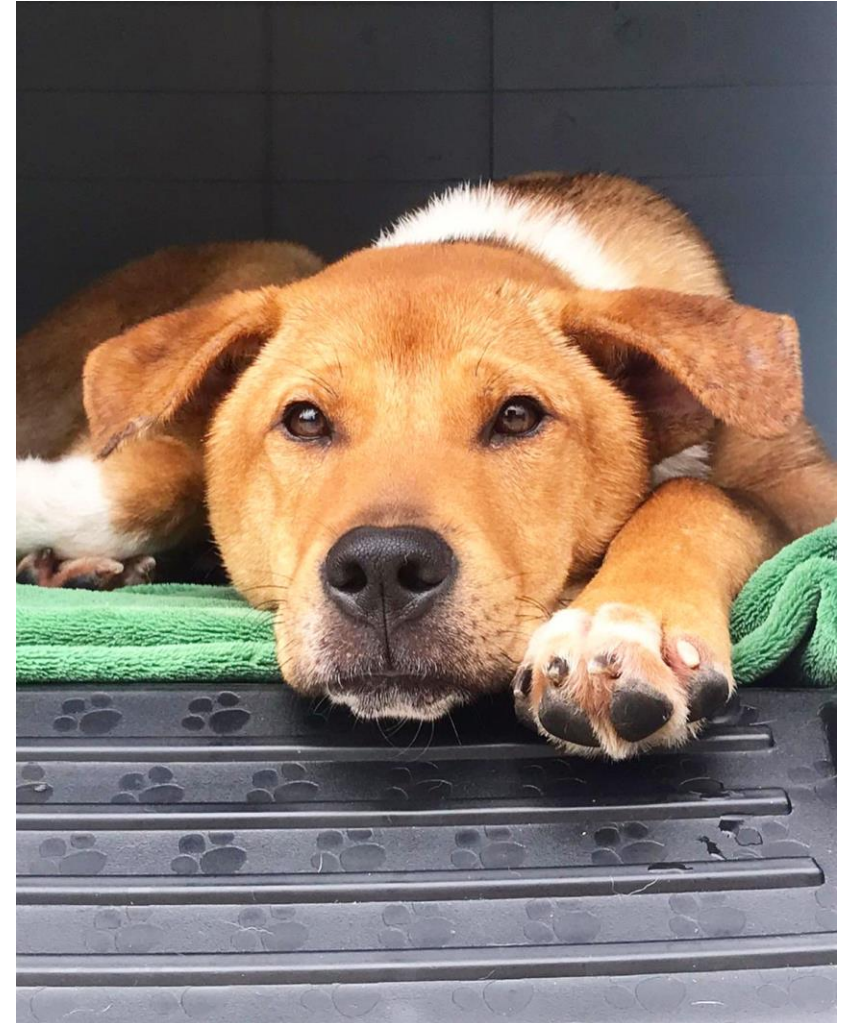
- 296 Animals Rehomed

Going into the second year of the pandemic has been challenging. There are more animals in need, but we are unable to do adoption or fundraising events. This has made it harder for our animals to meet fosters and adopters, and harder for us to cover costs. Yet, we have been very fortunate! We received two grants which took pressure of our food and medical bills, and let us renovate a section in our collaborating kennel for our use. This section enables us to provide immediate shelter for emergency animals while we match them with fosters, thereby significantly increasing the number of animals we can rescue. Further, we are grateful to Life Works Products Ltd for their generous cash donation to purchase a much needed van for animal transport; and we owe our gratitude to Dr Catherine Cormack and Jo Lodder for their Hike for Freedom Fundraiser that not only raised funds but also promoted our message of animal welfare and advocacy to an international audience. Due to the grants and our supporters, we were able to take in 30% more animals than in 2020, despite the pandemic challenges. That's 30% more lives saved. We are looking forward to 2022 with hope and excitement, and will continue to #keepthemwagging!

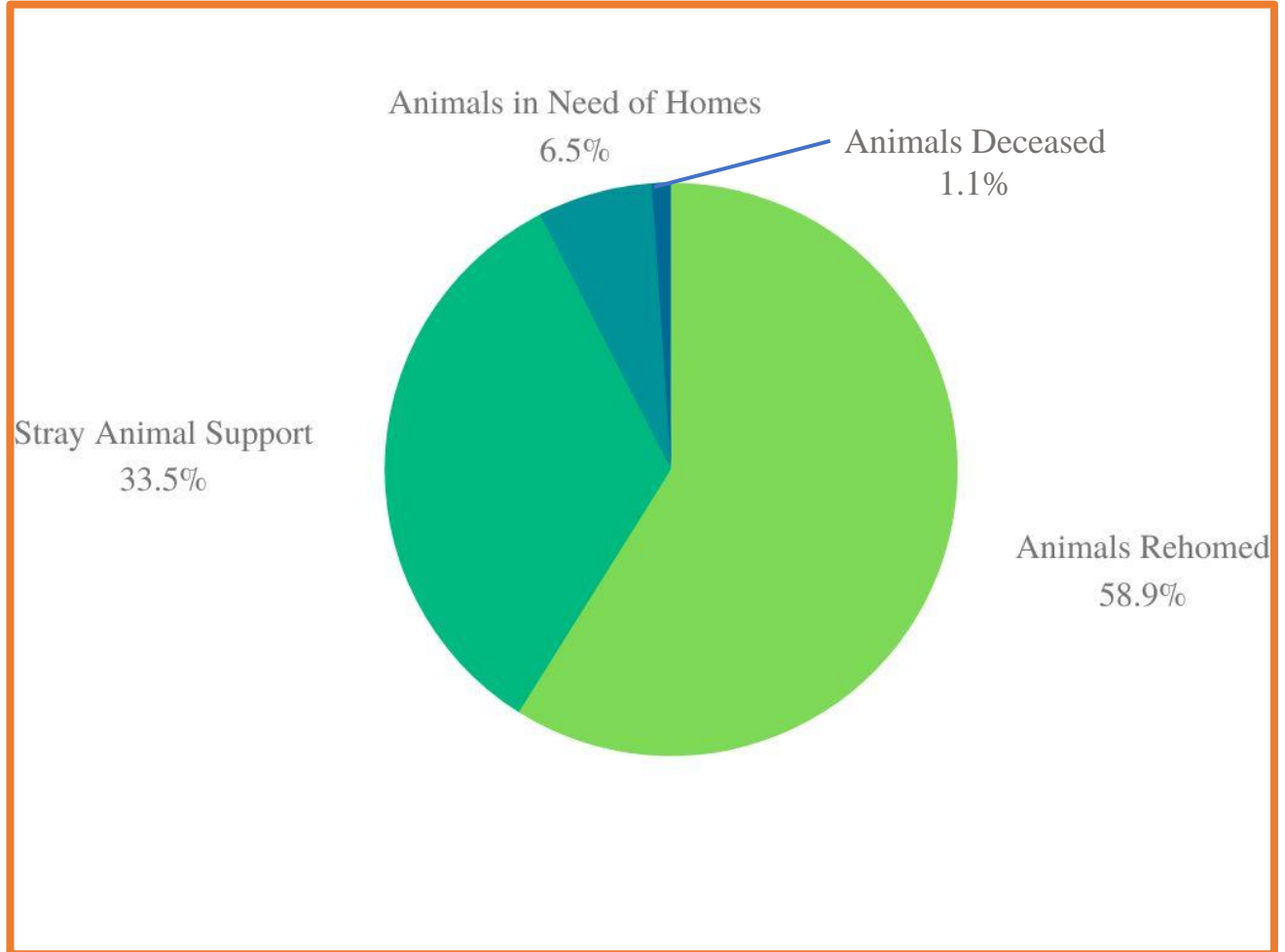
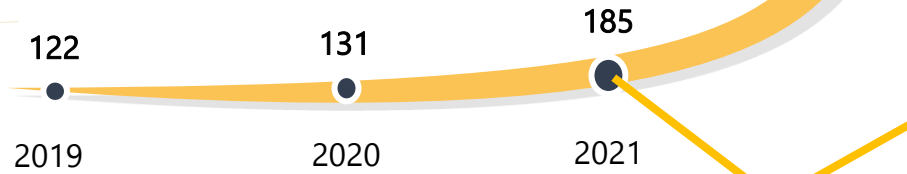

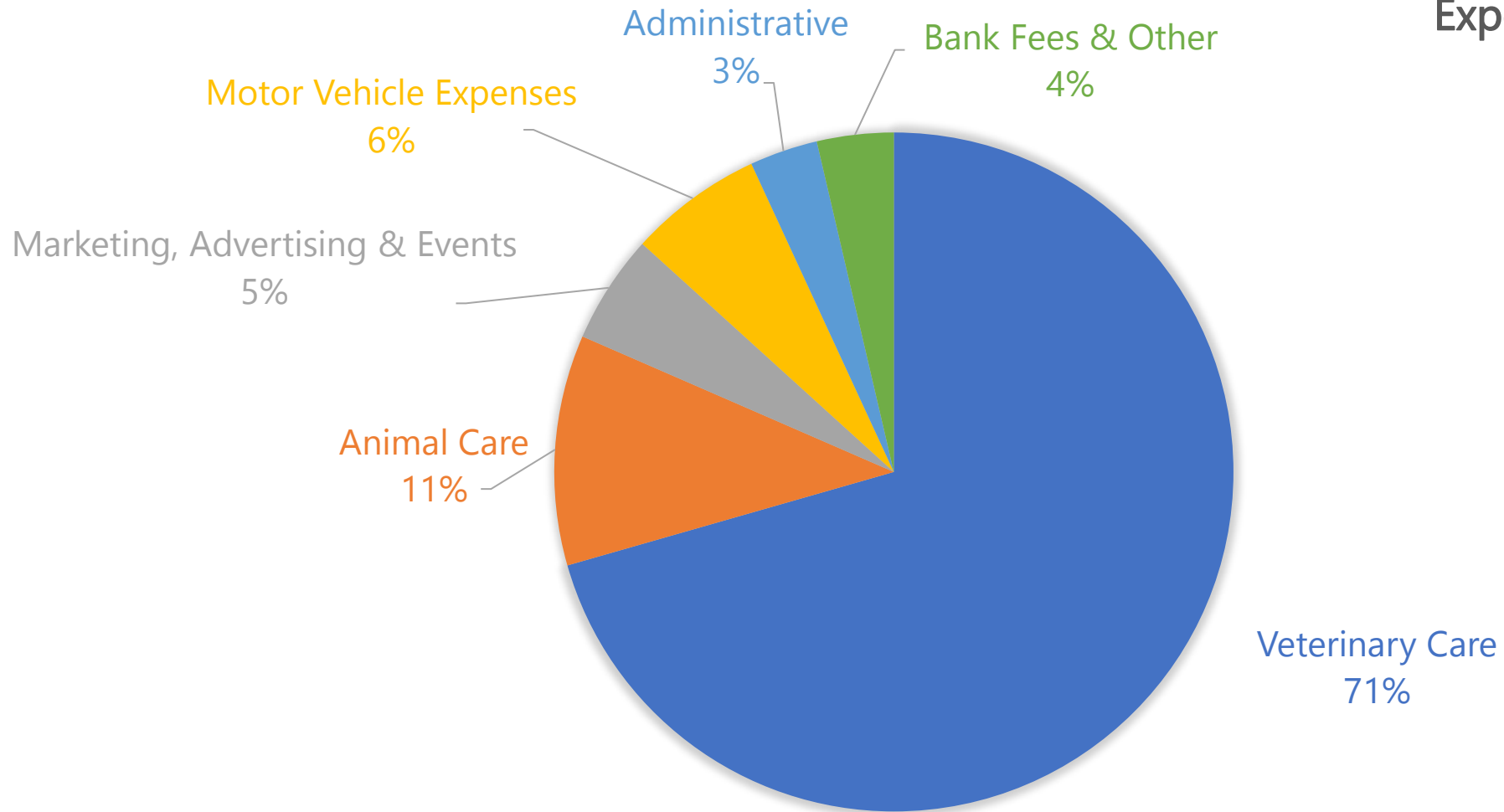
Income Breakdown
